# **5.7 Crisis Prevention**

The Finnish Student Health Service (FSHS) offers mental counselling and crisis therapy for students.

### Åbo

Treatment need assessment and appointment: Appointments from Mon-Thu can be made between 8.00-15.00, Fri between 8.00-14.00 on +358 (0)46 710 1050. In acute cases please contact between 8.00-9.00.

#### Vasa

Treatment need assessment and appointments for students: call the general health service number on +358 (0)46 710 1097 from Mon-Thu between 8.00-15.00 and on Fri between 8.00-14.00. Consultations/appointments with a psychologist or psychiatrist is also available if necessary via the service number.

When the FSHS health care centre in Vasa is closed: pleace contact your own health centre Mon-Thu between 8.00-16.00 and on Fri between 8.00-14.00. ## 5.8 Pharmacies (apotek/apteekki)

In Finland, practically all medicines are sold only at pharmacies (*apotek/apteekki*). These include e.g. painkillers. Medication that is prescription-free in other countries often requires a prescription in Finland. However, painkillers, vitamins and micronutrients (Calsium, Magnesium, etc.) are available without a prescription. Vitamins and micronutrients are also sold in grocery stores. Pharmacies are normally open: Mon-Fri 9.00-18.00 and Sat 9.00-15.00. In Åbo there is unfortunately not a single pharmacy open 24/7, and only one pharmacy is open 7.00-23.00 every day: Universitetsapoteket/Yliopiston apteekki, Universitetsgatan 25; phone: +358 (0)300 20200.
