

The Nordic Wittgenstein Society. Styrelsesmøde, October 26, 2016

1. The NWS homepage

The board suggests that the homepage is moved to a WordPress version. Camilla Kronquist will be asked whether she will initiate the move. If the move is successful, all board members will be given access to edit and update the homepage. It is also decided that the society establishes a page on Facebook. The secretary will initiate this.

2. NWR -- editor, platform etc.

The editors of the last two years, Martin Gustafsson and Anne-Marie S. Christensen are finishing their final issue, the last issue of 2017. The new editors for the next two years, Tove Östermann and Gisela Bengtsson have already started their work on the first issue of 2018.

The general editor Yrsa Neumann wants to resign after an impressive period as general editor. She has talked with Simo Säätelä about taking over as general editor and they have agreed on a gradual transition. The board supports this, and thanks Yrsa for her fantastic work for the journal.

The editors of NWR suggest that the NWR engages temporary editors or article editors, to copy-edit particular articles before printing. The board supports this suggestion.

The platform of NWR are being moved from the server at the University of Bergen to the Bergen University Library that offers help to update and maintain the platform and also houses other OJS journals.

At the annual meeting of the NWS, there was a suggestion to separate the boards of NWR and NWS. The board decided that one does not have to be a member of the board of the NWS to be a member of the board of NWR. Members of the board of NWR are appointed by the board of NWS.

3. The 2017 NWS conference in Åbo

The 8th NWS Conference is entitled 'What's wrong (and what's right) with Ordinary Language Philosophy?' and is to be held at Åbo Akademi University, May 5-6, 2017. The organisers for NWS are Kim-Erik Berts, Lars Hertzberg and Yrsa Neuman. The invited speakers are Avner Baz (Tufts University), Jason Bridges (University of Chicago), Robyn Carston (University College London), Niklas Forsberg (Uppsala University), Marina Sbisà (University of Trieste)
