About the Bernoulli Society

The Bernoulli Society for Mathematical Statistics and Probability was founded in 1975 as an Association of the International Statistical Institute (ISI). Established in 1885, the ISI is one of the oldest scientific associations operating in the modern world.

The objectives of the Bernoulli Society are the advancement of the sciences of probability (including stochastic processes) and mathematical statistics and of their applications to all those aspects of human endeavour which are directed towards the increase of natural knowledge and the welfare of mankind.

The Bernoulli Society has a membership of more than 1000 representing nearly 70 countries from all the continents. The Society has partnered with some societies to offer joint membership with reduction in dues by joining both organizations at the same time.

The Bernoulli Society sponsors several scientific high level standards publications on its own or in strategic association with commercial publishers and other scientific societies.

As one of its main activities, the Bernoulli Society organizes or sponsors several international meetings which have prominent relevance and strong traditions. The meetings are often held in conjunction with the Bernoulli Society regional and subject committees and other professional societies.

The Society is led by an Executive Committee and a Council. In addition there are several standing committees for specific administrative functions, the development and advancement of specific subject areas in mathematical statistics, probability theory and stochastic processes and their applications, and the support of activities that promote the cooperation within geographical regions.

Publications and Meetings

The Bernoulli Society official journals are Bernoulli and Stochastic Processes and their Applications (Elsevier). In addition, the BS co-sponsors the following open-access online publications: Electronic Communications in Probability, Electronic Journal of Probability, Electronic Journal of Statistics, Probability Surveys and Statistics Surveys.

Published twice a year, Bernoulli News provides detailed information about activities of the Society, while Bernoulli E-Briefs is a bimonthly electronic information bulletin that summarizes and draws the attention of relevant information to the membership.

The Bernoulli Society organizes or sponsors several international meetings which have a prominent relevance in the fields of mathematical statistics, probability, stochastic processes and their applications. These meetings are often held in conjunction with the ISI and other ISI Associations, the IMS or by the BS Regional and Standing Committees. Some of the meetings with a proud tradition are the World Congress in Probability and Statistics every four years, the Conference on Stochastic Processes and their Applications (SPA) organized every year (except the year of the Bernoulli Society World Congress), the ISI World Statistics Congress (formerly ISI Session), the Latin American Congress in Probability and Mathematical Statistics (CLAPEM) organized every two or three years, the European Meeting of Statisticians (EMS) organized every year except when the ISI World Statistics Congress takes place in Europe and the European Young Statisticians Meeting (EYSM) organized every two years.

Joining the Bernoulli Society is a way of supporting connections across the worldwide community of statisticians and probabilists. Getting involved in the Bernoulli Society is an excellent way of making scientific friends across the world. This can be done by running conferences; serving on the Society committees; sharing news and information with other members through the Bernoulli Website and/or Bernoulli News; attending meetings; presenting initiatives to the Executive Committee, etc.

Like all sciences, probability and mathematical statistics are disciplines which know no boundaries. Joining the Bernoulli Society is one way to express this in tangible form and is an important step towards establishing a broad global network of professional relationships to sustain one's professional career over the long term.
