Time schedule issues

The platform is being built. Deadline for submissions Dec. 1. AP and YN are allowed to extend the deadline as they see best.

The first issue is to be out in print August 1 2012. Feb 1. 2012 reviews in, 1-2 months final review.

Application NOP-HS status: no news, decision expected in November.

About the platform

The NWS board will test the platform when it is ready for testing. AP & YN will notify the board.

Reviewers will register as users and all advisory board members will be asked to sign up as reviewers.

Contents

Peer reviewed section of 7 articles, invited paper, archive section (new primary but also previously published sources), book review section.

Editing process

The editing process will be anonymous/blind. Only once the texts have been selected will the editors know who wrote them. At the stage when the reviewers are assigned in practice in the platform, YN will check that no author gets his or her own text to review. The other editors will not know the identity of the authors at that stage.

1. Papers submitted
 2. First rejection of irrelevant by papers by editors
 3. Reviewers assigned by editors
 4. Editors select texts for publication based on reviews,
 5. In case they cannot make a final decision based on reviews they should consult the editorial board.
- Peer reviewed selected papers will be put out for comments after acceptance at the protected space: "Open review".

The board decided that the debaters in the Open review stage shall be asked to appear under their own names.

LH will make a suggestion for a review form. It shall be as simple as possible with an open prose field for the evaluation, and only a few boxes to tick for the final decision.

The submitters will be asked which reviewers they hope to get in the online submission form.

The 3rd conference of the Nordic Wittgenstein Society:

Philosophy, Pedagogy, and Method

The general theme of the conference is to explore a Wittgensteinian approach to the interplay between philosophical method, pedagogy and philosophy of education.

Teaching and various forms of instruction, teaching and learning are recurrent themes in the writings of Ludwig Wittgenstein, and his influence is rapidly increasing in the philosophy of education. Wittgenstein's work is a prominent influence in debates of the pedagogies of philosophy, in debates of therapeutic and dialogical methods in education in general as well as the discussion of the respective contribution to education from empirically based methods and tools from philosophy of education.

The conference will include three key note speakers as well as a number of smaller presentations organised in sessions according to theme. Final programme will be announced later.

PhD Session

At least one of the sessions (depending on number of participants) will be reserved for presentations from PHD students. The keynote speaker NN will participate in the discussions of the presentations.
