



3rd Pharmaceutical Sciences Fair and Exhibition

The Pharmaceutical Sciences Fair and Exhibition (PharmSciFair) gathers academia and industry to discuss relevant topics within the area of pharmaceutical sciences. This year the conference was clearly focused on nanomaterials and their use in future medicine. Other topics were for example strategies to combat neglected diseases, pharmaceutical process modelling and simulation, vaccine delivery and drug discovery from nature. The European Federation for Pharmaceutical Sciences (EUFEPS), one of the leading organizers of PharmSciFair, celebrated their 20th anniversary with a special afternoon session that ended with an award ceremony.

My own work was presented in the Young Scientist Meeting, which has previously been a separate pre-satellite meeting for students, but was this year running parallel to the PharmSciFair. Young scientists were given their own poster and presentation session in order to encourage them to present their work and to be able to do so in a friendly environment surrounded by fellow students. Young Pharmaceutical Investigator Awards were given to the most outstanding oral and poster presentations. In the poster session we were given five minutes to present our work and I was one of the students to receive the Young Pharmaceutical Investigator Award.
