

## **Nuclear Receptors: Orphan Brothers**

**March 18 – 23, 2006, Banff, Alberta, Canada**

This meeting concentrated on orphan nuclear receptors and their roles in health and diseases. Results from different fields of orphan receptor research were presented, while the main focus was on understanding the function and the role of orphan receptors in metabolic pathways. The conference consisted of four full days of interesting lectures from the leading scientist of the orphan receptor research. Many novel techniques for nuclear receptor research were introduced and the poster session gave me an opportunity to discuss my results on estrogen receptor-related receptors with other people working on that field. The conference was also very well organized with some time for short day trips to discover the nature around the conference location. The location was superb: magnificent hotel in the middle of the Canadian Rockies mountains and nature reserves.
