

Summer School in Structural Biology

19.-27.9.2005, at the island of Spetses, Greece

The summer school, organized by the Protein Science Ph.D. School of the University of Copenhagen, focused in protein folding, protein structure and membrane proteins. The course took place at the island of Spetses, in Spetses Hotel, which was a very suitable location. The program consisted of lectures by specialists both in the field of NMR and x-ray crystallography. In addition, each student participating in the course was obliged to give a short presentation of his/her research subject. The students were also divided into question panels, which, in advance, prepared questions for the student presentations.

The summer school was well organized and the lecturers were well chosen. The students came from all around Europe, which gave us a great opportunity to discuss and compare how Ph.D. studies differ from each other in the European countries. If the summer school is organized next year, I warmly recommend it to the Ph.D. students of ISB.
